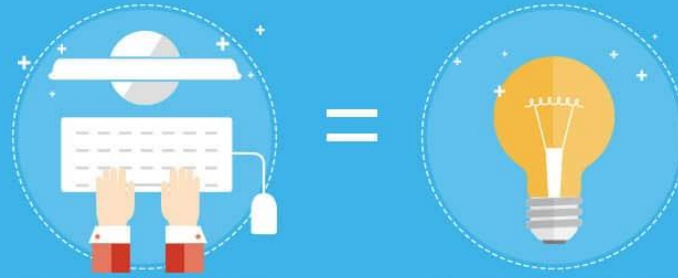

- **One central location and source of truth for *your* management and maintenance**

Use to date:

- To date **10,424 carriageways across New Zealand have been accepted.**
- Of the top 10 RCAs using the centreline 8 are District Councils and 2 are Cities.
- Collectively these **10 RCAs have accepted 83% of centrelines changes.**
